GUIDELINES ON TRADING ARRANGEMENTS

DURING TYPHOON, BLACK RAINSTORM

AND OTHER EXTREME CONDITIONS

To ensure the general public understand the trading arrangements of Micro Connect (Macao) Financial Assets Exchange Co., Ltd (“**MCEX**”) during Typhoon, Black Rainstorm or other Extreme Conditions¹, MCEX hereby releases the following guidelines.

If the Macao Meteorological and Geophysical Bureau ("**SMG Macao**") has issued Typhoon Signals, Black Rainstorm Warning or other Extreme Conditions, investors are advised to pay attention to announcements published on the MCEX's website to be aware of the trading arrangements. Unless otherwise specified, MCEX adheres to the following arrangements:

Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above/Black Rainstorm Warning are issued by SMG Macao or other Extreme Conditions are in force in Macao prior to the trading hours (i.e., from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on trading days)	
Typhoon Signal No. 8/Black Rainstorm Warning or other Extreme Conditions discontinued at or before 7:30 a.m.	Trading on MCEX will take place as usual.
Typhoon Signal no. 8/Black Rainstorm Warning or other Extreme Conditions continued as at 7:30 a.m.	The morning trading session (09:30 a.m. -12:00 p.m.) will be cancelled until further notice.
Typhoon Signal no.8/Black Rainstorm Warning or other Extreme Conditions discontinued at or before 12:00 p.m.	Trading on MCEX will resume within two hours as of the discontinuation of the Signal/Warning/Extreme Conditions.
Typhoon Signal no.8/Black Rainstorm Warning or other Extreme Conditions discontinued after 12:00 p.m.	No trading for the day.

¹ “Other Extreme Conditions” referred to in these Guidelines include, but are not limited to, fire, epidemic or other accidents, typhoon, rainstorm, earthquakes, natural disasters, power outages, communication breakdowns, computer failures, wars, riots, civil commotion, strikes, terrorist attacks, and other Extreme Conditions that may have a serious and detrimental impact on MCEX’s operations. Under such conditions, MCEX shall have the sole discretion to take any measure (including but not limited to the adjustment of trading hours) as it deems necessary or appropriate for those Extreme Conditions.
